#### **Special District Offices Proposition 119 (STATUTORY) Ballot Measures** Ballot questions referred by the general assembly or any political subdivision are listed by letter, and ballot questions initiated by the people are listed numerically. A ballot question listed as an "amendment" proposes a change to the Colorado constitution, and a ballot question listed as a "proposition" proposes a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes. A "yes/for" vote on any ballot question is a vote in favor of changing current law or existing circumstances, and a "no/against" vote on any ballot question is a vote against changing current law or existing circumstances. # **Proposition 120 (STATUTORY)**

Shall there be a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes concerning property tax reductions, and, in connection therewith. reducing property tax revenue by an estimated \$1.03 billion in 2023 and by comparable amounts thereafter by reducing the residential property tax assessment rate from 7.15% to 6.5% and reducing the property tax assessment rate for all other property, excluding producing mines and lands or leaseholds producing oil or gas, from 29% to 26.4% and allowing the state to annually retain and spend up to \$25 million of excess state revenue, if any, for state fiscal years 2022-23 through 2026-27 as a voter-approved revenue change to offset lost revenue resulting from the property tax rate reductions and to reimburse local governments for revenue lost due to the homestead exemptions for qualifying seniors and disabled veterans?

# Moffat County School District RE-1 **Ballot Issue 4A**

SHALL MOFFAT COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT RE-1 DEBT BE INCREASED UP TO \$38.52 MILLION WITH A REPAYMENT COST OF UP TO \$62.95 MILLION AND SHALL DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED BY UP TO \$3.15 MILLION ANNUALLY, TO PROVIDE LOCAL MATCHING MONEY REQUIRED FOR THE DISTRICT TO RECEIVE \$6.48 MILLION IN AWARDED "BEST" GRANT FUNDS (WHICH ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE REPAID) AND FINANCE CAPITAL PRIORITIES IDENTIFIED IN THE DISTRICT'S MASTER PLANNING PROCESS INCLUDING: - EXTENDING THE USEFUL LIFE OF EXISTING SCHOOL FACILITIES THROUGH INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS, INCLUDING ROOF REPLACEMENTS, DRAINAGE NO/AGAINST | IMPROVEMENTS, CONCRETE AND ASPHALT REPAVING, AND PLUMBING, MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL INFRASTRUCTURE; - FACILITY UPGRADES FOR SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY USE; AND - SAFETY AND SECURITY UPGRADES AT ALL CAMPUSES; WHICH DEBT SHALL CONSIST OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS TO BEAR INTEREST, MATURE, BE SUBJECT TO REDEMPTION, WITH OR WITHOUT PREMIUM, AND BE ISSUED AT SUCH TIME, AT SUCH PRICE (AT, ABOVE OR BELOW PAR) AND IN SUCH MANNER AND CONTAINING SUCH TERMS, NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THIS BALLOT ISSUE, AS THE BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY DETERMINE; AND SHALL AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES BE LEVIED WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO THE MILL RATE TO GENERATE AMOUNTS, NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNTS SET FORTH ABOVE SUFFICIENT IN EACH YEAR TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SUCH DEBT AND TO FUND ANY RESERVES
